




## EAA Oshkosh

The weeklong airshow is sponsored by the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) and is the largest of its kind in the world. This book showcases the many types of aircraft that have appeared there, from canvas-covered biplanes to brawny warbirds to home-built models. The traffic makes the control tower in Oshkosh the busiest in the world. It's an adventure to be sure, and the highlights are all here.




## Fail U




## Until Friday Night




## The Memory Painter






## Nature of the Beast




## Purity




## The Swarm




## Bad Kitty Scaredy-Cat






## Behind Closed Doors

Everyone knows a couple like Jack and Grace. He has looks and wealth, she has charm and elegance. You might not want to like them, but you do. You'd like to






## Trouble with Twins




## Sweet Tomorrows


## By the People

Americans have it within their power to make the federal government an insurable hazard like hurricanes, leaving us again free to live our lives as we see fit.

In 1974 Patty Hearst, heiress to a fortune, was kidnapped by a group calling themselves the Symbionese Liberation Army.

They released a tape of Patty saying she'd joined them and adopted the name Tania. The turns of the tale are astonishing—cameras capturing “Tania” wielding a gun during a robbery, a cast of characters ranging from the Black Panthers to Ronald Reagan, the largest police shoot-out in US history, the first breaking news to be broadcast live cross-country, Patty's circuslike trial, after which “Stockholm syndrome” entered the lexicon.



## Razor Girl

When Lane Coolman's car is hit from behind, it's anything but an accident. Driving the other car is Merry Mansfield—the Razor




## Dark Matter




## The Perfect Horse




## Heroes of the Frontier




## My Life on the Road

Gloria Steinem had an itinerant childhood. When she was a young girl, her father would pack the family in the car every fall



Unexpectedly, his reduced circumstances provide him a doorway into a much larger world of emotional discovery.
